This streamlined module takes less than 30 minutes to complete and covers critical reminders, including content that UNSW is legally or contractually required to deliver each year.

Please review the key information below so you can support your teams.

Who needs to complete it?

- All active fixed-term, continuing and casual staff who commenced in 2025 or earlier will be automatically enrolled. Current casuals must complete it, and staff on extended leave must complete it on their return.
- New starters in 2026 will complete the three core modules and will do the Refresher next year.

What do managers need to do?

? Encourage timely completion. To remain compliant, staff are expected to complete the Refresher Training within 30 days of enrolment. Please discuss the Refresher with your teams and let them know they will be allowed time for completion.
